Webster Pond Junior Anglers Rules & Regulations

1. Fishing will be permitted on Saturdays ONLY from 8 am to 12 Noon from April through September
2. All Junior Members will sign in and out personally.
3. All Junior Members will carry their membership card at all times and show it to any Senior Member upon request
4. All trout caught will be listed by their size and kind. If no trout are caught, enter "O".
5. There will be no fishing in front of the barn or on the west side of pond.
6. BAIT: Lures, flies, and live worms ONLY.
7. Any type of rod and reel may be used. One rod per member will be permitted. Rod must be attended at all times. No "forget" lines or "set" lines allowed. Unattended lines may be confiscated.
8. All Junior Members will have their own stringers. Please be sure that stringer is secured so that fish caught will not be lost and to also insure the safety of fish eating birds residing at the pond.
9. No guest brought to the pond by Junior Members may fish.
10. All Junior Members shall observe the limit of two trout per Saturday. When the limit has been caught, the line will be removed from the water, and fishing will end for that day. If any other kinds of fish are caught, they may be either kept or placed in the bucket provided for that purpose. Bass may be released.
11. There will be no horseplay, foul language, throwing of stones or other objects, wading, swimming. No radios are permitted. There will be no littering, discarding of line, hooks, bait containers or food. Each member will pick up any trash nearby and discard it in the nearest refuse can provided for this purpose.
12. If any wildlife (turtles, ducks, etc.) are accidentally snagged with a hook, seek help from a Senior Member immediately! Turtles are not to be kept and must remain in the water until such Senior Member can assist in its release.
13. *All wildlife has the right of way!!* Anyone caught abusing wildlife in any way is subject to dismissal for the rest of the season.
14. This program is a privilege extended to you by the Anglers Association of Onondaga. These rules will be strictly enforced. Anyone caught violating them will lose their fishing privileges. Senior Members have the right to confiscate membership cards. Please observe the rules of good sportsmanship so that this program can continue to be a success.
